Essential Functions

The Training Specialist conducts focused educational/training needs assessments result within specified targeted FMC (Fisheries Management Council) and Blue Swimming Crab Sustainable Fishery Committee (KPPRB) members; designs, develops, delivers, and evaluates a range of responsive educational curricula and training programs within defined fields of expertise. The TS will support the Training and Learning Program by coordinating and assisting the Training Manager and Fisheries Capacity Development Advisor in implementing training and learning activities. He/she will enhance the competencies of individual members of FMC and KPPRB by designing and conducting training programs that will boost the committee member's workplace performance in accordance with their specific fisheries management goal. The TS will be responsible for performing training needs assessments (if needed), designing and delivering curriculum and learning materials, conducting training sessions and for coordinating all phases of training interventions.

- Bachelor's degree in marine biology, fisheries, or marine science with 5 years related work experience or equivalent combination of education and experience
- Strong knowledge on fisheries rules and regulations at national and provincial level

- Teaching and facilitation skills
